Theme:	'Technology & Humanity' (or its variations like 'The Humanity of Technology' or
	'The Technology of Humanity')
Film Duration:	60 seconds
<b>Entry Guidelines:</b>	Each participant or team (up to 4 members) can submit up to 3 entries.
Technology:	Films can be shot using any equipment available (e.g. smartphones. cameras)
	Creativity is more important than technical sophistication.
Submission	Participants can submit their film, through a link where the video is uploaded on
Guidelines:	any online platform with public access including You Tube/ GDrive/ OneDrive /
	Vimeo, etc. The submission should include the film file, a brief synopsis (50-100
	words), and participant information (name, age, contact, details).
Judging Criteria:	Films will be evaluated based on creativity, appeal, clarity of message, overall
	impact and jury discretion
