Establishment of the School Innovation Council (SIC) and Funding support for Patents through KAPILA (Kalam Program for IP Literacy and Awareness) Program

School Innovation Council (SIC) is a novel initiative to foster a culture of ideation, innovation, entrepreneurship, creative thinking, design thinking, prototyping, out-of-box thinking, and IP commercialization, which will establish and strengthen the Innovation and Entrepreneurship ecosystem in schools. The School Innovation Contest of SIC aims to motivate, handhold, and nurture the bright ideas and Innovations of school students and fund the selected innovations to build Products/ Patent filing / Technology/Start-ups. https://sic.mic.gov.in/

So far, more than 25,000+ teachers have completed the School Innovation Ambassador Program (https://sia.mic.gov.in), and more than 5,100 schools have registered for School Innovation Council.

Kalam Program for IP Literacy and Awareness (KAPILA) for Schools was recently launched on 4th September 2024, to create an awareness regarding the need of IP filing, mechanism and methodology involved in filing IP in India, especially amongst students and teachers of Schools.

The objective of KAPILA is to recognise, facilitate and felicitate the Intellectual Property, Innovations and Best Practices in Schools. The scheme provides financial assistance to the schools (1000 patents filing & examination fee) for filing patent.

All CBSE schools are advised to establish School Innovation Councils (SICs) according to the guidelines on the SIC website (https://sic.mic.gov.in). New Registrations are open now. Schools that have previously established SICs are advised to log in, carry out innovation activities for 2025-26 as per the Activity Calendar of SIC.

Additionally, teachers and students under school education who have filed the patent for their idea after 1st April 2023, are eligible to get full reimbursement on the patent filing fee (Rs 1600) and examination fees (Rs 4000) through KAPILA program (https://sic.mic.gov.in/kapila_for_schools). Schools may apply for a maximum of 5 patent fee reimbursements in an academic year.

It's requested that the schools, include School Innovation Council (SIC) as a Co-circular activity in their academic calendars to foster the culture of innovation among teachers and students for Class VI-XII.
