CIRCULAR

To, Heads of Institution of affiliated Schools of CBSE.

Sub: Reminder for uploading of prescribed mandatory documents and staff details on Schools' website.

Ref: CBSE Circular Nos. CBSE/AFF/03/2021 dt. 05.03.2021 and CBSE/AFF/09/2021 dt. 21.05.2021 (copies attached).

Sir/Madam,

The Board vide Circular No. 03/2021 dt. 05.03.2021 (SI. No. 3 Clause 2.3.8 and SI. No. 5 Clause 2.4.9) had issued directions to all affiliated school to develop their own individual website and shall upload details of teachers with qualifications as well as prescribed information and documents as part of Mandatory Public Disclosure, according to the format given in the cited circular, under Appendix-IX.

The Board, vide Circular No. 09/2021 dt. 21.05.2021, once again directed to schools to comply with the above provisions within a period of one month, failing which the Board shall be constrained to take necessary action against the erring schools as per provisions mentioned in Chapter 12 of CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2018.

However, inspite of the repeated directions by the Board, it has been observed that many affiliated schools still do not have a functional website. Besides, some schools though have a school website but have either not uploaded or partially uploaded the desired information and documents, under Mandatory Public Disclosure.

In some cases, it is observed that schools have though uploaded the desired information/documents but the links to these documents are inactive. Few schools have although uploaded the prescribed information/documents, but the icon/link of the same is not prominently displayed on its Main Home page.

Therefore the Board is giving one final opportunity to all affiliated schools who have not yet complied with the above instructions, with a direction to carefully go through both the circulars cited above and upload all prescribed information and documents in an unambiguous and absolute manner within 30 days of the issue of this Circular, failing which the Board shall be constraint to initiate necessary-proceedings and imposing penalty against the erring schools as per Chapter 12 in accordance with Chapter 13 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, without any further reminder.

Those schools who have apparently complied with the given directions are also instructed to revisit their website and verify the uploaded information & documents vis-a-vis the directions given herein in the light of the cited circulars. In case of any disparity, the same ay be updated immediately.







To bring the transparency and build up trust among the stakeholders, CBSE has been giving emphasis on "Mandatory Public disclosure" of relevant information by its affiliated Schools. This information has to be displayed on the schools website as per clause 2.4.9 of Affiliation Bye laws 2018, as per the format prescribed in Appendix IX of Circular dated 05/03/2021.

The format of Mandatory Public Disclosure along with the relevant circular is once again attached for ready reference.

The schools are informed to display the same on the Home page itself of the school website under an icon "Mandatory Pubic disclosure". The icon link so posted on the schools' website should be distinctly visible for easy accessibility. It is important that this information is easily accessible to the public and therefore the link on the website should be prominently displayed.

In this connection, it has been observed that inspite of clear directions from the Board, some of the schools are not following these provisions. It is therefore, reiterated that it is imperative on the part of the schools to comply not only with the provisions of State Education department but also with the provisions of the Affiliation and Examination Bye-Laws of the Board, to bring transparency and easy accessibility by stakeholders.

The Central Board of Secondary Education has also made it as a mandatory pre condition for granting or extending affiliation. The School leaders and Managers of the schools are directed to take note of the above condition and comply with the provisions mentioned in circular dated 05.03.2021. If it has not been complied with already, the same may be done within a period of one month failing which the Board will be constrained to take necessary action as per provisions mentioned in Chapter 12 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2018.
